#### **COLLEGE RULES**

#### Admission and withdrawal

- 1. All candidates for admission must acquaint themselves with the rules and regulations of the college and will be bound by them if admitted.
- 2. They must produce before admission their transfer certificate and certificate of conduct from the school or the college which they last attended and their SSLC book and their university pass certificate (if issued by the university) if they are applicants for admission to the B.Com, BBA,BCA, BA, M.Com classes.
- 3. The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission to any applicant, without assigning reasons.

- 4. No candidate for admission will be enrolled or allowed to attend any class, until the prescribed fees has been paid.
- 5. Anyone who is found to have obtained admission by false representation is liable to dismissal and forfeiture of the fees paid.
- 6. Any student who leaves the college without the prior permission of the Principal, before completing his/ her course will receive no certificate of character but on sufficient cause being shown, the Principal will transfer a student to another college, or will allow him to discontinue his/ her study and may give him a certificate of character.
- 7. Character certificates must be applied for as soon as the students leave the college.
- 8. No students shall be considered to have been enrolled in any college unless he/ she has attended the college at least one day of that term or has paid the fees or portion thereof prescribed.
- 9. A student who has discontinued his/ her studies may be given his/ her SSLC book or university pass certificate, and T.C. if he/ she pays the dues up to the end of last term in which he/ she attends. 10. No student who has not previously studied in any recognized school or college shall be admitted to the college unless he/ she presents a transfer certificate.

11. Every transfer certificate issued to the students from a college or other institution after being registered for a university exam shall necessarily contain the following details:

- a. Name of the examination of the university for which the student has been last presented from the college.
- b. Register number of the student and date of examination.
- c. Whether the student has appeared for the examination . If yes:
- i. The parts and division in which the candidate has passed.
- ii. The parts and division in which he or she has failed.

NOTE:- (a) Transfer certificate to a student who has been enrolled for a university exam shall be issued only after the provisional results of the exam are published and every such certificate shall contain the details of the parts or division in and every such certificate shall contain the details of the parts or division in which he/ she has passed and the parts or division in which he/ she has failed. No student can be admitted to the college pending the production of such a certificate.

- b) The first October of every year has been fixed by the university as the last date for receipt of return of matriculates relating to students for recognition of the qualifying examinations of other universities or examining bodies, admitted every year are to be received at the university office within one month after their joining the college.
- c) In respect of delay in the admission of application by individual applicants (in respect of return of matriculates and recognition of any qualifying examinations) a penalty of Rs. 2/- (Per candidate) is levied by the university.
- d) Application for transfer certificate shall be in the prescribed form.
- 12. In the case of students who have passed from any university other than the Mahatma Gandhi University, the necessary migration certificate / no objection certificate must be produced within a month after enrollment.

- 13. Certificate such as SSLC books, university mark lists, degree certificates etc. of students, will not be kept for more than three years after completion of their course of study.
- 14. Megaphone, loudspeakers etc. should not be used and posters, banners or boards should not be put up in the campus without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 15. Conduct certificate is a document which the student has to earn. It will not be issued as a matter of course. Application for conduct certificate should be given as soon as the student leaves the college.

#### CONDUCT, DRESS, BEHAVIOUR AND DISCIPLINE

1. No student shall indulge in smoking or other reprehensible habits within the College premises. Also students should not fold up their dhothis in the College premises and they should refrain from sitting and standing on staircases, leaning against parapet or loitering idly in the verandahs.

No student shall enter or leave the class without the permission of the lecturer until the class is dismissed.

- 2. Use of Mobile Phones is strictly prohibited in the college campus (even after class hours).
- 3. Writing or making marks on walls or on furniture, throwing paper anywhere except in waste paper receptacles and dropping ink in the floor of the College is prohibited.
- 4. Students are not permitted to join or work for any organization outside the College without the written permission of the Principal.
- 5. Students are warned against presenting mass petitions to the Principal. They can make representations regarding College affairs to the higher authorities only through the Principal.
- 6. Except in the meeting of various College Associations, no student shall address any gathering within the college premises without the permission of the Principal.
- 7. When a student has any doubt in any matter of College discipline, he should consult the Principal before making his decision.
- 8. The loss or damage caused to College articles will be made good by realizing from the student concerned, the value of loss or damage.
- 9. Be clean and decorous in dress, language and behavior.
- 10. No student shall enter a class other than his own without the permission of the Principal or the staff members whether it is before, during or after the College working hours.
- 11. When a teacher or a guest enters your class you should rise and remain standing until he takes his seat or desires you to resume yours.
- 12. Do not enter Computer lab without the permission of teachers in charge.
- 13. Order and restraint should characterize your conduct at all times and perfect silence should be maintained in the library, lecture classes and laboratories.

- 14. Do not disfigure College walls, desks or benches with writing or engraving of any description whatsoever and do not tamper with or damage fittings, articles of furniture or library books.
- 15. Do not participate in (a) any agitation directed against constituted authority (b) any meeting likely to excite disloyalty or disaffection towards the Government (c) any movement likely to promote communal ill-feeling.
- 16. The actual loss caused to furniture, tools and apparatus of the College during strike period due to violent action of students will be made good by imposing collective fines on all students of the College(as per Government order)

The management of Mar Baselios College, Adimaly has decided to implement the following rules and regulations also in order to facilitate the smooth and effective work of the College, in addition to the above rules.

- i. All the students in the College shall co-operate with the College Authorities to ensure maintenance of discipline in the College.
- ii. All strikes, demonstrations, dharnas, harthals and the like are banned in the College campus. Students who violate the above rule are liable to be dismissed from the College summarily.
- iii. Students are prohibited from taking part in any meeting in the College campus unless such meetings are convened and organized by the College Authorities.
  iv. Political activities are completely banned in the College campus. Students including in and involving themselves in any kind of political activity in the College campus are liable to be summarily dismissed from the College.
- v. No student shall bring into the College campus any banner, flag, board, notice, pamphlet etc. for purpose of any political activity.
- vi. No student shall involve in any activity which may cause disruption to classes or disturbances in the College campus. If any student violates the above regulation, he /she is liable to be dismissed from the College itself summarily.

#### **UNIFORM**

Uniform is compulsory on all week days except on Wednesdays. It should be stitched in comfort-executive model. No alterations are permitted.

#### **IDENTITY CARDS**

Every student is expected to have in his or her possession an identity card issued at the time admission. Students should wear the identity card inside the College campus. It should be worn around the neck by the tag attended so as to be exhibited always. Identity card is also compulsory for entry in to the University examination hall. It must be produced compulsorily on the day of College election and on other days deemed to be fit by the Principal for entry into College campus. If the card is lost, a duplicate may be issued at the student's expense with the special permission of the Principal on submission of a written request for a duplicate card, attested by the parent or guardian.

#### ATTENDANCE AND LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Attendance will be marked at the beginning of each hour by the teacher engaging the class. If a student is absent for one hour, it will be treated as absence for half a day and if his / her absence is for two or more hours, it will be treated as absence for one full day. A student requiring leave for only a particular period may be granted such leave by the teacher concerned.

Application for leave for more than a period must be made to the Principal in the prescribed form annexed to this calendar.

Absence without leave from any examination or practical work will be reported by the teachers concerned to the Principal. Leave of absence from any internal examination should be obtained from the Principal.

Absence without leave for more than ten consecutive days will cause removal of the student's name from the rolls and he / she may be re-admitted on payment of College dues, if any.

Every application for leave shall be countersigned by the student's guardian and recommended by the class teacher or the head of the department. For hostel students the warden's recommendation is sufficient:

The minimum attendance prescribed by the University is 75% of the working days in the academic year/ semester. Exemption from shortage of attendance (subject to a minimum of 20 days/ year or 10 days semester) can be granted by the Syndicate on recommendation of the Principal, provided leave has been applied for and granted for such absence on satisfactory grounds. Such condonation will be granted only once during a course. (Twice for semester scheme).

#### **RAGGING STRICTLY PROHIBITED**

Ragging of any kind is strictly prohibited in the College campus. Any case reported will be seriously dealt with and, if necessary, will be referred to the police. The Students who indulge in any kind of ragging will be expelled from the College. The Kerala Ragging prohibition Act1998 is given below.
